We would also love to share your adventures through our social media and website so prospective adopters get a little glimpse of the wonderful reality of adoption.





# Mallow lambs

## Ingredients


- Chocolate teacakes/mallows
- Milk chocolate to melt
- White mini marshmallows
- Large white chocolate buttons
- Black ready-made icing in a tube

## Tools

- Pastry brush

## How to make it

1. Ask an adult to help you melt a few squares of chocolate in the microwave – try 20 seconds to start with as chocolate can burn very easily
2. Brush the top of the teacake/mallow with the melted chocolate
3. Start adding the mini marshmallows in a single row around the circumference of the teacake/mallow starting from the bottom and finishing at the top
4. Draw some sheep faces onto your chocolate buttons and stick them onto your sheep using the icing or melted chocolate if you haven't eaten it all!!




